Goal: Provide opportunities for participants to encounter Christ.

Objectives:

- Daily Liturgy of the Eucharist.

- Exposition with Adoration.
- Authentic speakers and presenters that are knowledgeable and passionate about the Catholic faith.

Objectives:

Goal: Build community and healthy connections between local church leaders with youth.

Objectives:

- Free time to converse and enjoy the company of one another.
- Fun mealtime activities to provide laughter and interaction with others.
- Organized conversation with the Bishops of Alaska and others.
- Daily Liturgy of the Eucharist with a variety of presiders and priests that concelebrate.
- Personal invitation to local church leaders to prepare and present a workshop at ACYC.
- Invitation to parish leaders to take on a variety of leadership roles in planning for and implementing the conference.

Goal: Encourage participants to return to their parish communities and be involved.

Objectives:

- Invite parish leaders to attend ACYC and journey in faith with the young people from their parish.
- Cantor, choir, music leader, lector, and other liturgical ministry training and opportunities.
- Pertinent and applicable workshops.
- Encourage parish leaders to bless the young people and chaperones before ACYC during a communal gathering and plan a series of follow up meetings afterwards.

Goal: Provide a glimpse and an experience of the larger universal church.

Objectives:

- Speakers, emcees, programs, and musicians from outside of Alaska intermixed with local church leaders.
- A variety of prayer experiences such as the Rosary, Divine Office, Lectio Divina, Mass, Exposition with Adoration, Benediction, spontaneous prayer, etc.
- Workshops, activities, and keynotes with an intentional and general focus of the universality of the church.

Goal: Provide opportunities to learn about the Catholic faith and a variety of ways to live it throughout our daily lives.

Objectives:

- Community building games and activities throughout.
- Service project(s).
- Pertinent and applicable workshops.
- Keynote addresses.
- Authentic adult leaders to accompany and journey in faith with the youth throughout the week.
- Well planned times of prayer & liturgies.
